Especially in the winter months, many of us have come to rely on the daily weather forecasts to prepare our activities and plans for the coming days: Our readings today also provide us with a kind of forecast, letting us know what to expect for those who put their trust in the Lord and those who don't. As we gather for our celebration today, let us reflect on where or in whom our trust is placed.

SUNDAY—FEBRUARY 7

Today is, of course, Valentine's Day...British social theorist Thomas Malthus, born today (1766), was author of the still-debated Malthusian principal, that population tends to increase at a faster rate than its means of subsistence and that, unless checked, such growth will bring widespread poverty and degradation...With the approach of Lent, we might note that February was the traditional Roman month of purification, introduced into the calendar by Numa, Pompilius, legendary second King of early Rome (715-673BC).

Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and thus you may be considering what to give up or do differently for Lent. Perhaps giving up a favorite drink or desserts can be a prayer prompt as we act in solidarity with our brothers and sisters in Haiti who do not have a choice.
