SUNDAY—FEBRUARY 21

On February 21, 1965, Black leader Malcolm X was assassinated after making a speech in Harlem (New York City)..... French poet and novelist Raymond Queneau, born today (1903), once commented: "Happy nations have no history. History is the study of mankind's mistakes....Also born today (1808) was John Henry Cardinal Newman who observed, "A great member does not make a mind, any more than a dictionary is a piece of literature....The New Yorker once called "the world's best magazine" but now reduced in statue, was first published on February 21, 1925....Today is columnist Emma Bombeck's birthday (1927).

PARENTING POINTERS

Lent is not just about "giving up" but also humbling oneself in the service of others. Even children can serve by cleaning up, letting someone else go first, even smiling instead of smirking. Being a willing servant is different from being a slave. "The last will be first, and the first will be last." (Matthew 20:16)
