TODAY'S LITURGY

Today on our Lenten journey we are drawn more deeply into the mystery of God, the "I AM" who speaks to Moses from the burning bush yet nevertheless tirelessly tends and cares for us who sometimes take so long to bear fruit in our lives. Let us pray for a spirit of repentance, that we may be more receptive to the nourishment that God gives us in this Eucharist and every day of our lives.

SUNDAY—MARCH 7

Even as the nation whose independence he proclaimed in 1918 has dissolved into two separate countries, we mark today the birth (1850) of Thomas Masaryk, philosopher and first president of Czechoslovakia. He once wrote: "This, then, is determinism: to learn to understand the causes of evil so that we may induce the causes of reform. Not to be a fatalist, a slave—a slave of one's self or a slave to one's surroundings. Whenever we are, not to work and not blindly but freely and consciously, to anticipate and plan like a worker and collaborator of God."

We've 15 days into Lent. Has your family found 15 things to give away to those in need? Maybe you've procrastinated? Maybe you're the only one in your family who decided to join the great Lenten give-away. Maybe you have better ways to sacrifice during Lent. It doesn't matter.
