TODAY'S LITURGY

Our Lenten journey brings us today to the story of the prodigal son—appropriately enough because today is also celebrated for LAETARE Sunday. Why not rejoice along with the loving father at the return of the wayward son? Let us pray today not only for the grace and courage to seek reconciliation with God and each other ourselves, but also for the graciousness to welcome to our table all the wayward souls who receive God's unconditional forgiveness.

SUNDAY—MARCH 14

Until the 20th Amendment to the US Constitution (1933), the American presidential inauguration took place in March instead of January. In honor of the former practice, let us note that today is the birthdate (1782) of US Senator and statesman Thomas Hart Benton, Democrat of Missouri. Of the American political order, hIS once observed: "There are but two parties—founded in the radical question whether people in property shall govern. Democracy implies a government by the people. Benton died in 1858, several years before Lincoln uttered his famous variation of the phrase in the Gettysburg Address. Aristocracy implies a government by the rich—and in these words are contained the sum of party distinction.

PARENTING POINTERS

What do you do when your child ignores a request from you? If this is a common problem, use the SET UP strategy: Stoop—to get on your child's level EYE-make eye contact; TOUCH—your child's shoulder to make physical contact. USE-direct language, "I want you to..." PRAISE-acknowledge your child's cooperation where he/she complies,

A FAMILY PERSPECTIVE

Our words and actions can crush or enhance children. The father in today's gospel did not allow a bruised ego, or "I told you so" come between him and his son but teaches important parenting lessons: (1) never give up on your child, (2) be forgiving, (3) be accepting and (4) show affection.
