- Sunday: Easter Sunday; Resurrection of the Lord; St. Isidore of Seville, bishop & doctor of the Church (560-636); Martin Luther King, Jr. died 1968; NATO established, 1940.
- Monday: Easter Monday; St. Vincent Ferrer, priest (1350-1419); Booker T. Washington born, 1856.
- Tuesday: Easter Tuesday; United States enters World War I, 1917.
- Wednesday: Easter Wednesday; St. John Baptist de la Salle, founder of the Christian Brothers, who teach at Central Catholic High School, Pittsburgh (1651-1719).
- Thursday: Easter Thursday; Pope Pius VII splits the first U.S. Diocese of Baltimore and creates the new dioceses of Boston, New York, Philadelphia and Bardstown, KY.
- Friday: Easter Friday; Robert Cavalier erects a cross at the mouth of the Mississippi River and names the territory "LOUISIANA"; Dietrich Bonhoffer died, 1945; Civil War ends: Lee surrender's to Grant at Appomattox Court House, VA, 1865.
- Saturday: Easter Saturday; Pope Benedict XV approves formation of the National Catholic Welfare Council, 1919.
