## **SUNDAY—MAY 16**

On May 16, 1770, there took place in Notre Dame de Paris the wedding of the Dauphin Louis (later King Louis XVI of France) and Marie Antoinette, daughter of the Austrian empress Maria Theresa; the couple, of course, did not live happily ever after.... Today is the birth date of Sigmund Freud (1856), who thought he had the answer: "Woman's basic fear is that she will lose love.".... American poet Randall Jarrell, also born today (1914), once noted, "We can escape from the level of our society, but not from the level of intelligence to which we were born."

## **TODAY'S LITURGY**

As the end of our fifty-day celebration of the season of Easter approaches, we listen in on Jesus' great prayer for his disciples and St. Stephen's prayer for his persecutors. Today with the vision described today in the book of Revelation, these prayers remind us of the future that we have in the Lord.
